1. University of Genoa

I have monitored, in particular, the activities performed by the University of Genoa.

Learning activities

At this regard, I can certify that the seminar and international conferences have been really successful, both under the point of view of the participants and of the scientific level of the initiatives.

More precisely, a large number of persons (approximately 200) participated to the seminar and/or international conferences.

Most of them were attorneys, who are member of the Genoa's bar Association.

However, the initiatives were welcome also by other persons having a professional interest and by students as well.

Furthermore, lectures and speeches during the conferences have all been characterized by a high scientific standard.

Research products

The University of Genoa provide all the participants to the seminar with a collection of the most significant materials (containing the relevant law and case-law), in order to make it easier to follow all the lectures and speeches.

These materials have been also uploaded on the official web-site of the REMOR Project.

The University of Genoa's staff is now collecting and adjourning all the relevant materials used during the seminars and conferences within an "e-book" code, which will be soon published by the Italian editor Giappichelli.

All the persons who hold lectures and/or spoke during the international conferences provided the University of Genoa's staff with a written report.
